

Memorandum of Understanding between National Sun Yat-sen University and

University of Sri Jayewardenepura

For the purpose of furthering cooperation in both education and academic research, National Sun Yat-sen University and University of Sri Jayewardenepura hereby affirm their intent to promote such academic cooperation and exchange as well as mutual benefit to their respective universities. Academic cooperation and exchange are considered to include but are not limited to:

- 1. Exchange of scholars and researchers;
- 2. Coordination such activities as joint research, lectures, and symposia;
- 3. Exchange of data, documents, and research materials in fields of mutual interest:
- 4. Exchange of students;
- 5. Double-Degree programs.

Details of the implementation of any particular initiative resulting from this MOU shall be negotiated between the two university units as each specific case may arise. Both institutions understand that financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

This MOU to promote academic exchange is subject to revision, renewal, or cancellation by mutual consent and becomes effective upon completion of the signatures.
