



LETTER OF INTENT

Between

UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA TERENGGANU, MALAYSIA

And

COLLEGE OF MARINE SCIENCES, NATIONAL SUN YAT-SEN UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN

This Letter of Intent is designed to foster a friendly international cooperation in accordance with our mutual interests in developing programs of academic and scholarly exchanges and for the purpose of establishing a mutually beneficial association, UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA TERENGGANU, whose address is at 21030 Kuala Terengganu, Terengganu, Malaysia ("UMT") and COLLEGE OF MARINE SCIENCES of NATIONAL SUN YAT-SEN UNIVERSITY ("NSYSU"), whose address is at 70 Lian-Hai Rd., Kaohsiung, Taiwan execute this Letter of Intent.

For the purpose of undertaking the activities under this Letter of Intent, UMT is represented by the School of Marine and Environmental Sciences.

The parties hereby agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:

- (a) promote mutual understanding, academic collaboration, cultural and personnel exchanges;
- (b) exchange of information and resources, promotion of joint publication and other scholarly communications;
- (c) assistance in the training of staff and students where means and facilities exist;
- (d) access to available research facilities; and
- (e) any other areas of cooperation as the Parties mutually agree in writing.

This Letter of Intent forms the framework for cooperation between the parties to identify and achieve shared goals and objectives and to facilitate and develop a genuine and mutually beneficial exchange process and research relationship. This Letter of Intent is non-binding and does not impose any legal or financial obligations or liabilities on either party. Both parties understand that all financial agreement will have to be negotiated and any activities to be undertaken under this Letter of Intent will depend on the availability of funds.

This Letter of Intent will remain in effect for two (2) years effective from the date of signing.
